<p>Update on VHSP Grants</p>	<p>First Quarter FY2016 Data: FHN members discussed quarter data. Tyronne Champion noted that those served through prevention by CTI is not reflected in the data and should be fixed.</p> <p>Tyronne Champion reported that to-date CTI served 34 households through housing locator services, 15 through rapid re-housing, and 4 through prevention. They expect to see an increase in requests for assistance in the winter.</p> <p>Tony Hooper asked if we have data on reasons why people are in their current housing situation, i.e. job loss, health emergency, etc. We currently do not collect this information through the FHN Screening Form.</p> <p>HMIS Changes: Fauquier Family Shelter will no longer participate in HMIS, but agrees to provide data quarterly to FHN.</p> <p>FHN has been working with Tonya Harris of Homeward to make changes to HMIS that will hopefully streamline data entry as much as possible. Even with these changes, the newest ServicePoint update (5.11), which complies with the 2014 HMIS Data Standards, has added several required fields. This lengthens the amount of time it takes for providers to complete data entry.</p> <p>Policy Issues: FHN members discussed whether or not we are reaching the most vulnerable. We cannot assist homeless clients until they find a lease, but how do we help more vulnerable clients obtain a lease? There is concern that we could spend our entire grant funding on helping a few clients. There is also concern that these clients may be less successful with rapid re-housing than those who are successful with shallow assistance.</p>	<p>Make sure CTI prevention clients are in HMIS.</p> <p>Collect FFSS data quarterly.</p>	<p>Kate & CTI</p> <p>Kate</p>

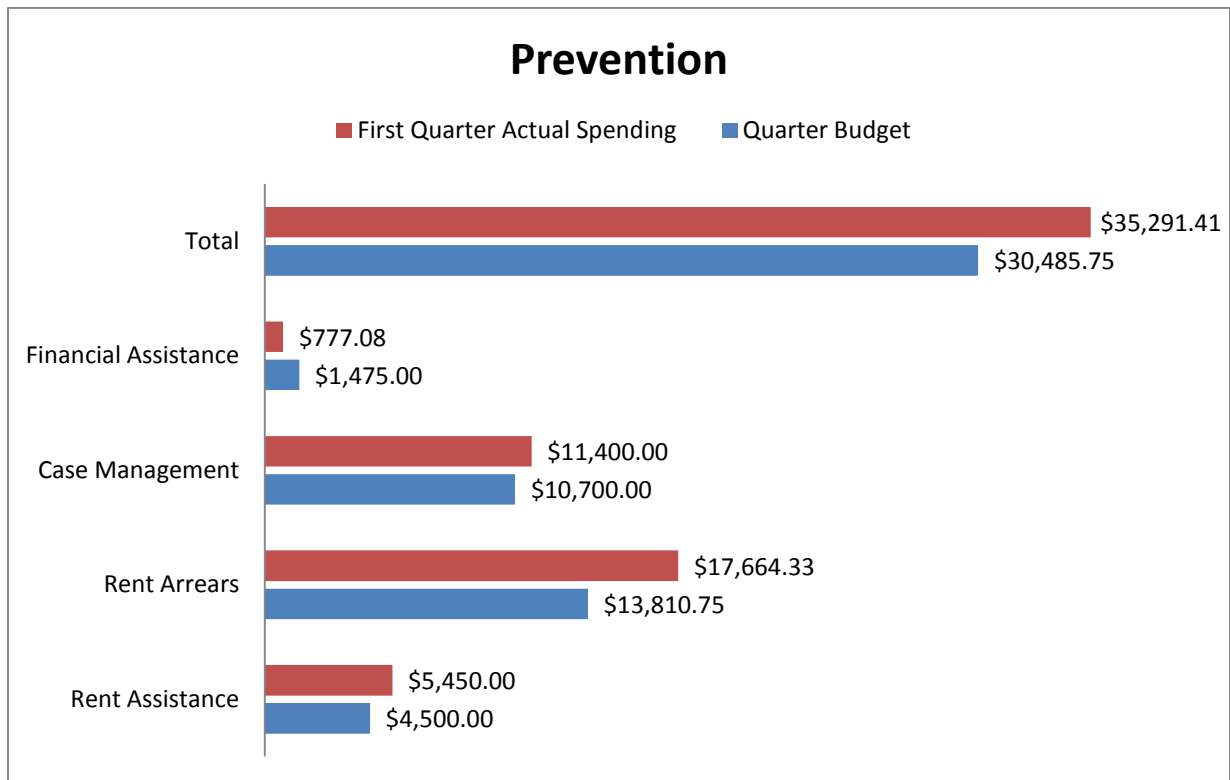

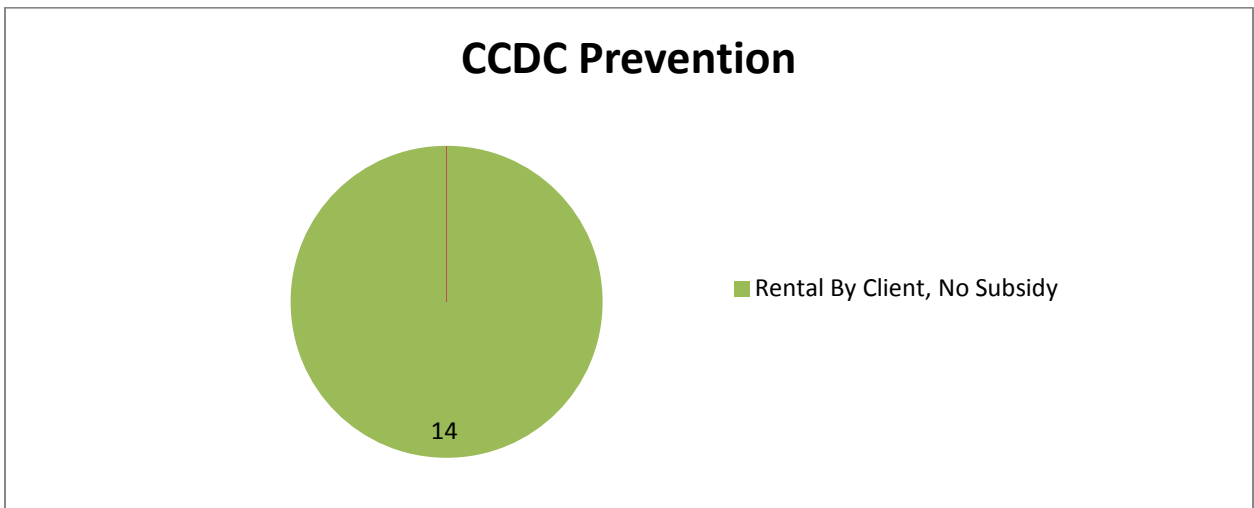
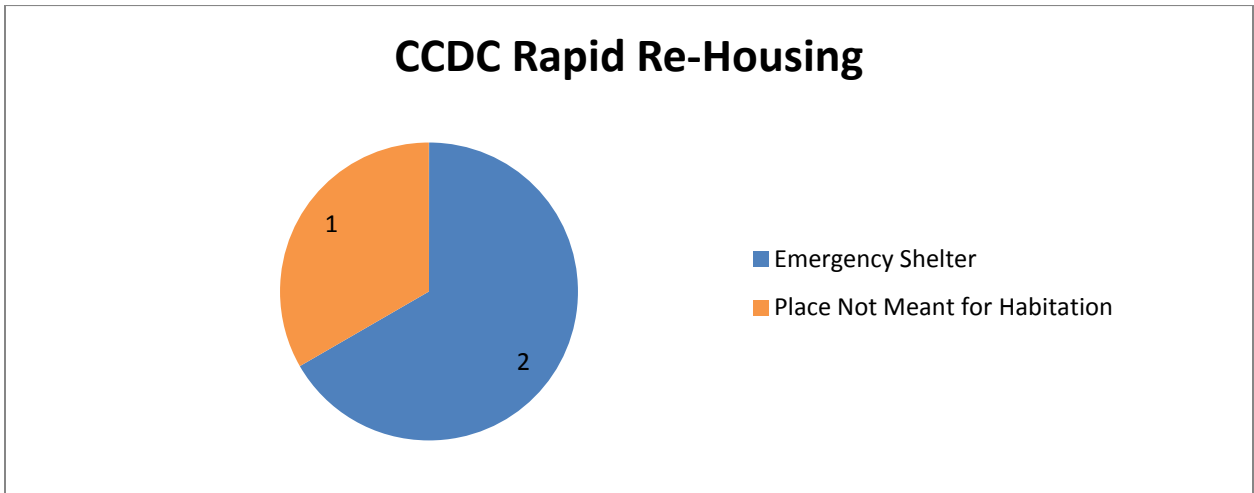
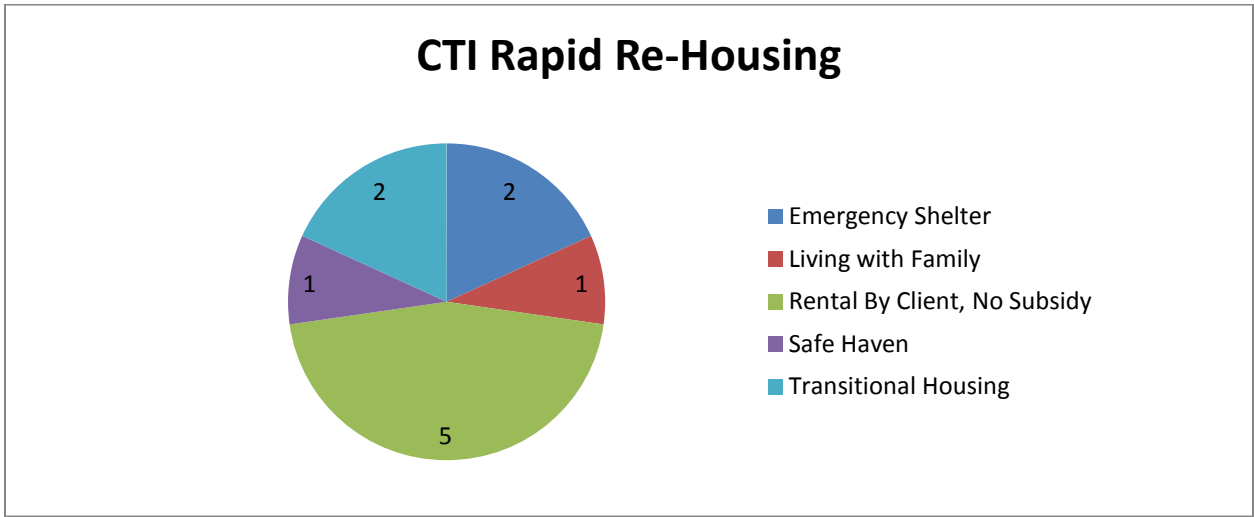
Fauquier County VHSP Grant: FY2015 Budget



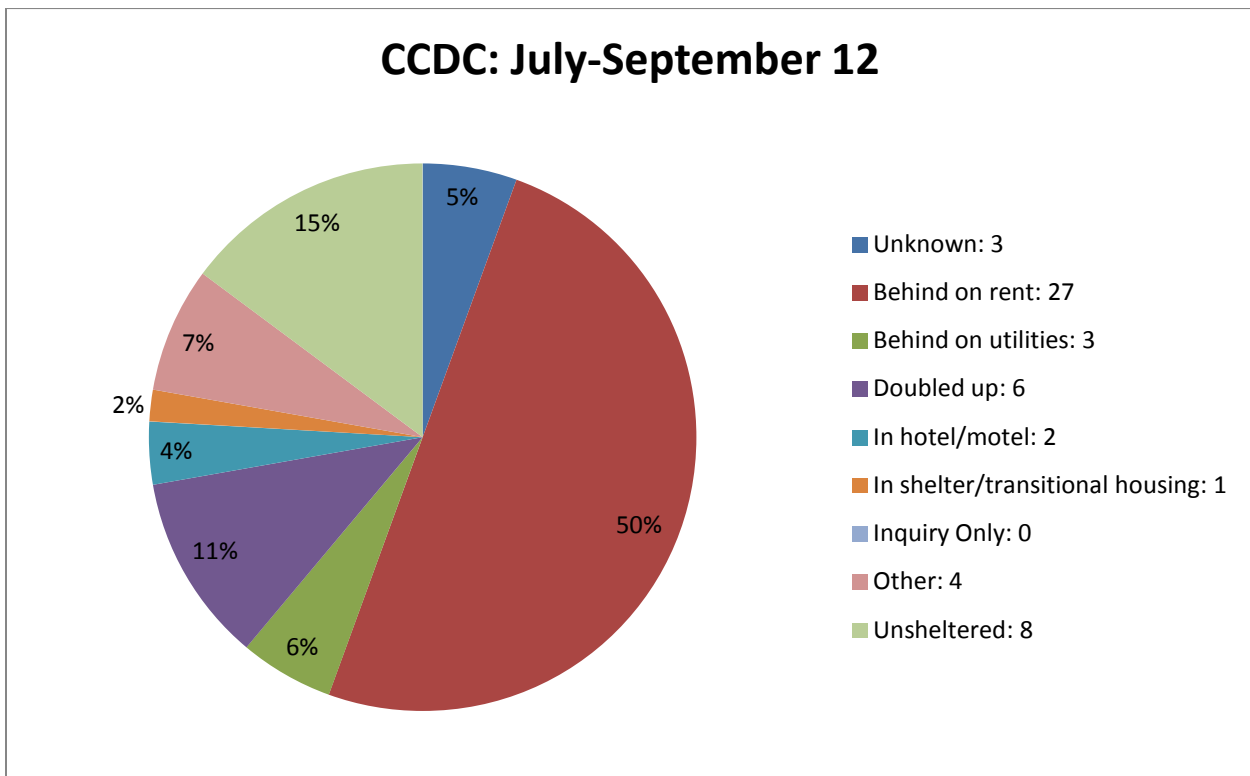
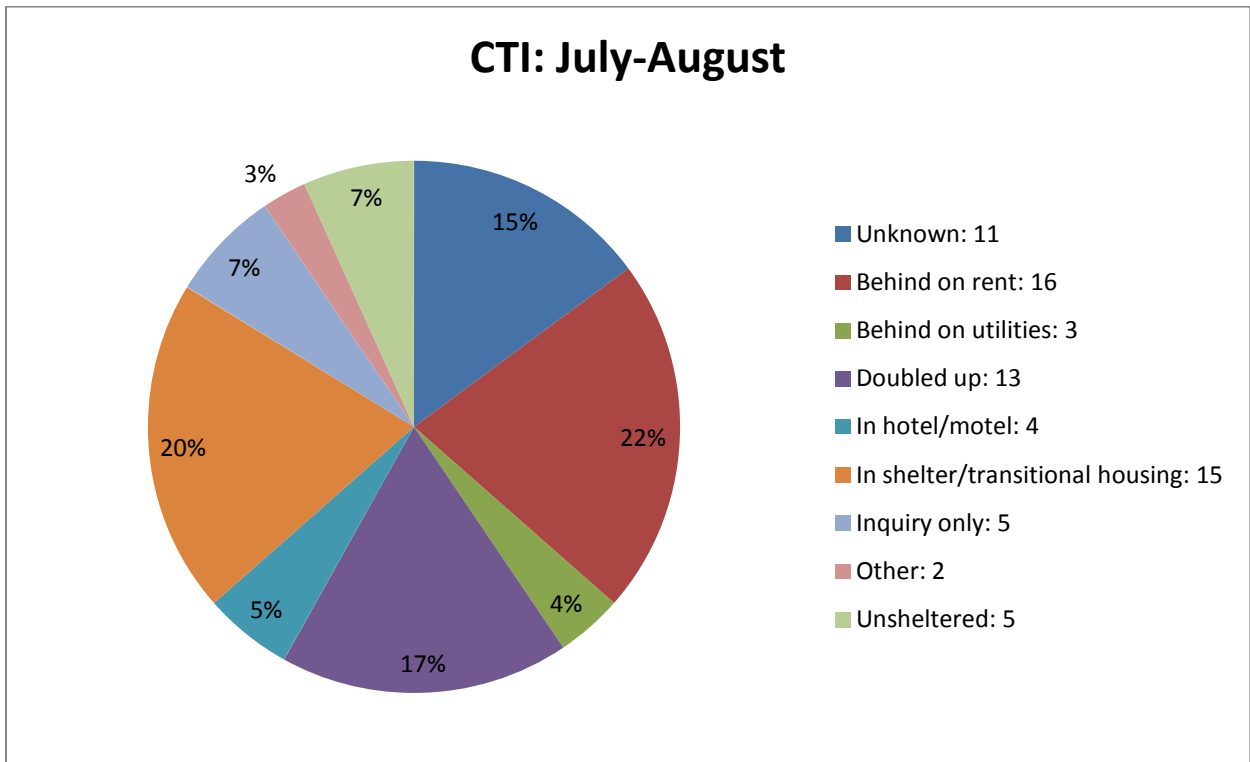
First Quarter Actual Spending vs. FY2015 Quarter Budget
